## **Beach Conditions**

The Captiva Erosion Prevention District (CEPD) has been monitoring the beaches and fish kills. We are getting more dead fish along the beach rack line as a result of shifts in recent winds and water current. The beach cleanup crew is re-mobilizing today and will start raking and cleaning beaches again tomorrow.

Additionally, Lee County contractors continue to remove the dead fish from our back bay waters.

A 4-yard dumpster has been placed at Alison Hagerup Beach Parking Lot with daily pickup on a temporary basis. We appreciate any assistance from visitors and residents who have been bagging dead fish in an effort to keep our beaches beautiful.
