
CAPTIVA BEACH RENOURISHMENT 2020/2021

The last Captiva erosion beach nourishment project was in 2013/2014 and was a huge success; the job came in under budget, costing the homeowners less than anticipated. The next project is being designed to begin in 2020/2021. As such, a special bond referendum is scheduled for March 5, 2019. The estimated cost of the project requires approval by the registered voters of Captiva, for a bond issue to be obtained to fund the beach renourishment project.
