

CAPTIVA EROSION PREVENTION DISTRICT
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Captiva Erosion Prevention District ("District") will hold a public hearing to adopt special assessments to be levied against each property within the District, in order to pay for the 2005/06 Beach Maintenance Nourishment Project. The hearing will take place at the Captiva Community Center Complex, 11550 Chapin Lane, Captiva, FL 33924, on Tuesday, July 24, 2007 beginning at 5:01 p.m.

At this hearing all interested persons may appear and file written objections to the confirmation of the special assessment roll.

The Captiva Beach Maintenance Renourishment Project is more fully described as placement of approximately 1.4 million cubic yards of predominantly medium grained sand from offshore borrow areas (located 8-9 miles north and west of the island), along approximately 6.23 miles (32,884 feet) of Gulf front shoreline, in a shore parallel direction southward from Department of Environmental Protection (formerly DNR) reference monument R-84; and having a non-uniform construction berm width which will vary from 30 feet to 300 feet and a seaward slope of approximately 1 vertical to 10 horizontal from the berm seaward to the intersection of the existing bottom. The project also includes the rehabilitation of the terminal groin on Captiva Island at Redfish Pass and extending the groin approximately 100 feet into the Gulf of Mexico to improve sand retention.

The tentative apportionment roll is on file in the District office.
