Engineers to Begin Post Hurricane Irma Survey

The Captiva Erosion Prevention District has contracted with APTIM Coastal Planning & Engineering to conduct a physical monitoring survey for Captiva Island following impacts from Hurricane Irma. The work will begin at the end of the week and encompasses the entire Captiva gulf front shoreline.

Following the collection of the physical monitoring survey, engineers will develop and submit a storm impact assessment report. The report will summarize and discuss the survey data and the impacts from Hurricane Irma on the Captiva Island nourishment project. The report will include a cost estimate to repair the damages and an update to the project performance for perspective on the timing of the next nourishment project.
