RESOLUTION 2026-6



A RESOLUTION OF THE CAPTIVA EROSION PREVENTION DISTRICT OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Captiva Erosion Prevention District (hereinafter the “District”) is an independent special district and beach and shore preservation district created and existing pursuant to Chapter 2000-399, Laws of Florida, and Chapter 161, Florida Statutes, being situated entirely within Lee County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2026, the Board of Commissioners for the District tentatively approved an operating millage rate of 0.3517 mills for the levying of ad valorem taxes for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 through the Lee County Property Appraiser; and

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2026, the Board of Commissioners for the District held a public hearing pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within the District has been certified by the Lee County Property Appraiser as \$__1,849,001,838__.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CAPTIVA EROSION PREVENTION DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. The District’s tentative operating millage rate for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 is 0.3517 mills, which is the rolled-back rate.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
