Beach Nourishment 2021



The project area was located between Florida DEP reference monuments R-84 and R-109 (Captiva Island).

The project consisted of the placement of approximately 800,000 cubic yards of beach fill along 4.85 miles of shoreline and rehabilitation of existing dunes along the entire Gulf of Mexico shoreline of Captiva Island between Redfish Pass and Blind pass.

The project, which was designed to last approximately 8-10 years, provides necessary maintenance to counteract long-term critical erosion of our beaches, properties, and shorelines.
