

Cost effective Beach Nourishment

The beach nourishment project was bid in March/April 2021 with a flexible construction approach that would provide an extended contract time period and include summer construction to allow for cost savings. The project was awarded to Great Lakes Dredge and Dock, LLC for \$15,625,485 for the flexible summer construction window, which attributed to approximately \$2.5M in cost savings. In addition, performing the project outside of tourist season, allowed for a more efficient timeline with minimal interruptions to our residents and visitors.

"We did this beach nourishment project during turtle nesting season, and by doing so, CEPD captured a cost savings of almost three million dollars to the Captiva Taxpayers. We have one person to thank for this, and that is commissioner Mike Mullins for this new process," said Rene Miville, Captiva Erosion Prevention District Chairman. "It's creative thinkers like Mike who give the Captiva Erosion Prevention District its nation-wide sterling legacy and reputation it deserves. Captiva can only hope to have more dynamic, big picture thinkers to get involved and contribute, such as Mike, in the future" said Miville.
